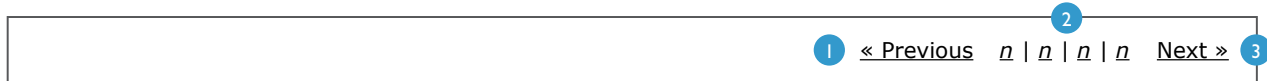

Article Pagination Modules

Rules

1. Should break by character count as chunked by paragraphs (i.e. should not break up paragraphs.)
2. Should not break up pages during short paragraphs.
3. Should roll short last pages in to the previous page.
4. Specifics:
 - i. 4,000 character pages.
 - ii. Short paragraph < 200 characters.
 - iii. Short last page < 2,000 characters.
 - iv. All counts include HTML.
5. Secondary pages retain all existing elements (drop-ins, comments etc.)
6. Include pagination controls at bottom of article body on all pages.
7. Secondary pages to indicate current page selection (e.g. page 2 of 2.)
8. Users will have the ability to toggle to single page display (see article tools drop-in.) If user selects single page view, article pagination modules are not displayed.

End of article body (see article page type doc for correct positioning)



1. Previous link/button.
Not displayed on initial page.
2. Page numbering, direct links to sub-pages.
Number of links dependent on length of complete article.
Current page selection should be reflected visually (property specific look & feel e.g. number is bold.)
3. Next link/button.
Not displayed on last sub-page.

Only displayed on sub-pages(>1)
