3. Editor created headline link.

Four to five lines maximum.
5. Optional sub-item links.  
Optional bullet at the beginning of each row.  
Number of rows tbd by editor's needs.  
Each row can be subdivided into separate links if needs be.  
Link delimiter to follow property specific look & feel.  
Optional icon can be associated with each link, also linked to associated link URL.
